Leaflet for the application for admission E-Kart international e.V.¹

1) Admission procedure

The written application for admission is decided about within four weeks after receipt, either on the occasion of the next board meeting or by written vote in the circulation procedure (according to § 12 No. 5 of the statutes).

2) General admission requirements for regular members

The company has to exhibit the current Europe-wide respectively nationwide safety-related standards.

3) Verification of the admission requirements for regular members

Prospectus and/or planning documents have to be submitted with the application for admission. If it is not recognisable without doubt that the company meets the admission criteria, an inspection of the company by one or more members of the board or an authorised representative will take place.

4) Special admission criteria for indoor electric kart tracks

Indoor electric kart tracks should have the following minimum equipment: definition of the minimum equipment

- Track length of at least 300m
- Varied routing (with regard to speed and bends)
- Catering with at least 30 seats
- Event areas of 50 m²
- A galery is desirable
- At least 8 karts per turn possible

5) Special admission criteria for outdoor electric kart tracks

Outdoor electric kart tracks should have the following minimum equipment: definition of the minimum equipment

- Track length of at least 500m
- Varied routing (with regard to speed and bends)
- Catering with at least 30 seats
- Event areas of 50 m²

6) Admission of supportive members

The supportive membership is applied for with reference to affiliation to the companies listed in §3 No. 5 para. 2 or by exposition of a particularly close connection to the leisure industry and especially to electric kart tracks.

1. Purposes of data processing and their legal bases

There is a variety of individual purposes for which you may contact us or we may contact you; the transferred and processed data may be just as versatile. We have put together the typical cases/purposes and presented you the usual data categories and the associated legal basis. We will inform you about other purposes that are not mentioned at the time of the elicitation (see table on page 2).

2. Duration of storage

The data is generally deleted as soon as it is not necessary for the achievement of the purpose of its elicitation anymore. Since the legislator has issued multiple different retention obligations, the data will be immediately deleted after the retention of these periods.

3. Recipients

The above-mentioned data is of course primarily processed in our company but it is only made available for the responsible specialist department or given them access. Because we cannot render all services of a modern business ourselves, we use different service providers/suppliers with whom we have reached appropriate contractual arrangements for the protection of your data. Other recipients can be, for example, governmental institutions that we have to submit data to because of legal obligations. We use the service providers for the following purposes, among others:

- Carrying out printing orders
- Measures of marketing
- Support and maintenance of IT services
- Support of motor sport events
- Hosting of websites

4. Possibility of contradiction, revocation and removal

You have the right to contradict to the processing of data for certain purposes. You can do that by writing to the contact information listed above. When the processing of your data relies on consent, you have the right to revoke this consent at any time. Unless stated otherwise, you can send the revocation in any form to the address or email addresses which are mentioned above.

5. Rights of the affected person

You are lawfully entitled to the personal data that we process about you: the right of disclosure, correction or deletion; the right to limit processing; the right of contradiction against the processing as well as the right of data transmission. Furthermore, you have the right to complain to a supervisory authority.
